

RECEPTION AND NURSERY LIVING EGGS - FROM 8TH APRIL

Living Eggs is a company that will provide us with an incubator and 10 fertilized eggs that will hatch into chicks over a 2 week period. Children will learn about the life cycle of a chicken and how to care for the eggs and chicks. Children will observe the eggs as they hatch and watch as the chicks dry their feathers in the incubator and become fluffy. Once hatched children will be able to handle the chicks, keep them clean and provide food and water. After two weeks the company collect the chicks and rehome them.


