## Living Eggs

Our Reception and Nursery Classes will be provided with an incubator and 10 fertilized eggs that will hatch into chicks over a 2 week period. This will take place between the 8th and 19th April. Children will learn about the life cycle of a chicken and how to care for the eggs and chicks. Children will observe the eggs as they hatch and watch as the chicks dry their feathers in the incubator and become fluffy. Once hatched children will be able to handle the chicks, keep them clean and provide food and water. After two weeks the company collect the chicks and rehome them.
