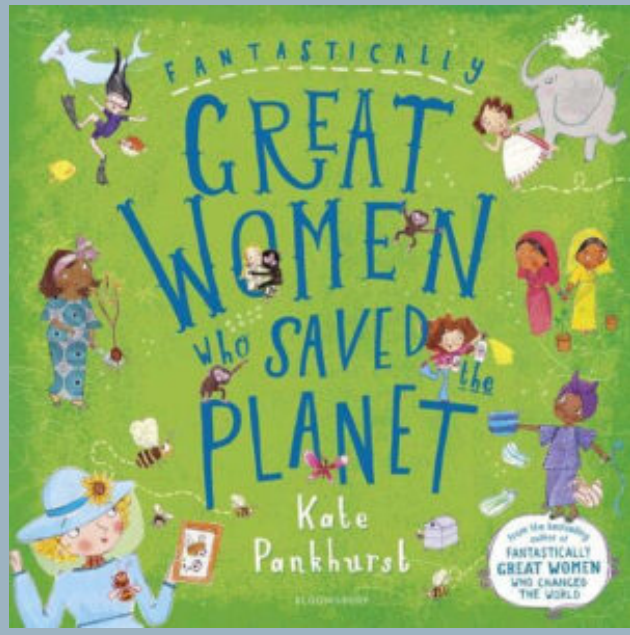
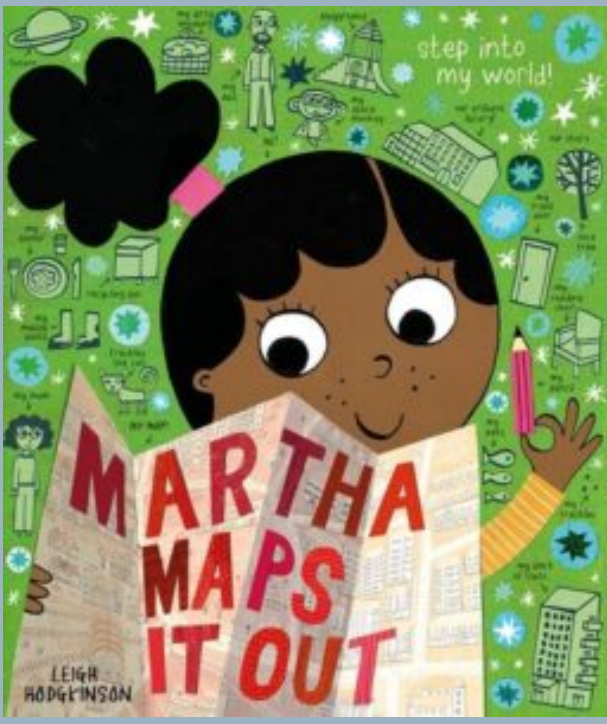


Class 6 first started reading 'The Accidental Prime Minister' in LIRA, however enjoyed it that much they chose it for their class story!
