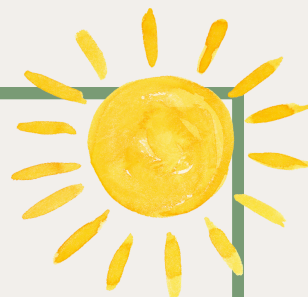
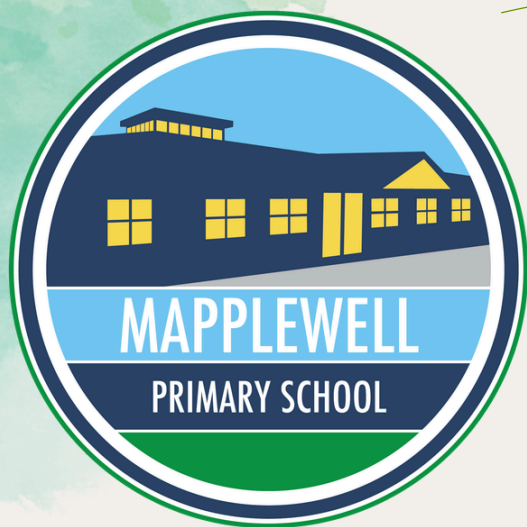

All pupils will be able to browse the book fair on certain days after school from **3:15pm to 4pm**

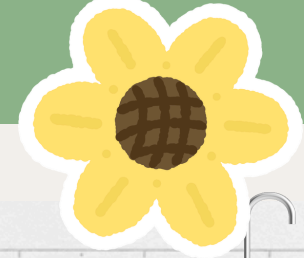

It will be cash free, parents can scan the QR codes displayed at the book fair to pay for their books.



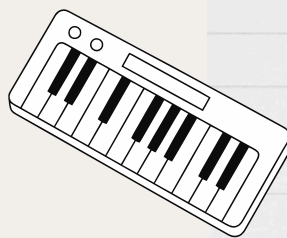

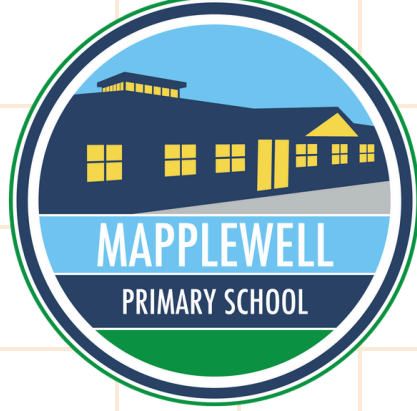
